Harp & Fiddle General Information

1. You may register on the field on the day of competition.
 - a. **Preregistration is recommended for all events.**
2. All events will take place in the Dogwood Glen Harp and Fiddle tent.
3. Scottish Highland dress (kilts, tartan sashes etc.) is strongly encouraged but not required.
4. The order of competition is determined by the postmark on the entry form; the first shall be last and last shall be first.

2010 Dogwood Glen Scottish Fiddling Competition

1. This competition is sanctioned by Scottish FIRE; Scottish Fiddling Revival (Scottish FIRE) rules will govern the competition. Copies of these regulations are available upon request.
2. There will be three competition categories:
 - Novice - A fiddler of any age who is new to Scottish fiddling. 1st - \$25 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10
 - Junior - Fiddlers under age 18 1st - \$25 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10
 - Open - Open to any fiddlers, but generally the category for more experienced players. 1st - \$200 and a trophy 2nd - \$100 3rd - \$75
3. The use of written music is permitted; competitors using music should bring a music stand.

3. All music played for this competition must be Scottish in origin or style & be memorized.

 - Rank Beginner 1st - \$25 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10
 - Novice 1st - \$25 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10
 - Apprentice 1st - \$50 2nd - \$25 3rd - \$15
 - Journeyman 1st - \$50 2nd - \$25 3rd - \$15
 - Master 1st - \$100 and a trophy 2nd - \$85 3rd - \$70

If time allows, there will be a non-graded category where a harper may play for the Judge's comments but not compete.
